### **Tortuga Trail Project**

Thanks to two grants (from Jewish Family and Children's Services and from United Way of Tucson and Southern Arizona) plus many generous donations from HOAs and individuals over the past few years, we are pleased to announce that completion of the Project is in sight. Late in August the remaining repair work on the east end of the Trail will be finished, followed by bench placement along the pedestrian pathway. If you are interested in joining a committee that plans occasional social or educational programs along the Trail, please let us know of your interest.

This three year old project is the outcome of resident input from focus groups, surveys, questionnaires and neighborhood conversations. A major portion of the Tortuga Trail Project was funded "In Loving Memory of Rita," who had a deep appreciation for the Fairfield desert. Total cost of this Project exceeds \$20,000.

Loma del Bribon).
